This week we have been thinking of others.



This week we have worked on the sounds b, h, f and the digraph ff.
This is our first digraph – two letters making one sound!
We have learned the tricky word 'go' and 'no'.
In handwriting we have practised letters and words with b, h and p, which are also in the 'Over the Bridge' family.



The children have continued to enjoy 'Maths Mastery', helping a puppet to learn how to count! We have counted small objects, sounds we cannot touch or see, and larger objects we cannot move. Some of the children made themselves a 'pointing finger' stick and then used them to count larger things around Reception.
