We have started our new topic – Are We There Yet?



This week children have revised some of the trickier digraphs in pairs, for example 'ai' and 'oi', 'er' and 'or', 'ar' and 'ur'. They have played a variety of games as well as practising how to write words that have these sounds in them.



Children have practised counting in 2s, 5s and 10s, using money as a context. We have also used our mathematical skills for our traffic survey. We had to count to some quite big numbers, especially for the cars and vans!



Other Areas of Learning

Our walk to Binley Road for the Traffic Survey was very exciting. The children walked safely with their partners in their hi-vis jackets, giving them an opportunity to develop their understanding of road safety. They were very excited counting the different vehicles, shouting out what they were seeing so the adults could keep a tally. Back at school, we compared the numbers of the different vehicle types, and the results for the different groups.

We have looked at different forms of transport and thinking about where they travel, so that we could sort them into groups.

The children have also made a transport card for the special day coming up on the 20th June!!
