Dear all parents and carers,

As we approach the end of summer term 1, I am delighted and I must say a little relieved that since returning to school on March 8th, we have had no positive Covid cases amongst the children and staff and have not had to close any of our class or year group bubbles.

This term we have caught up with some of the lost learning but as you will see from our class blogs, we have put an emphasis on PE, exercise, the outdoors and making learning fun!

Despite restrictions easing and some aspects of life returning to normal, our risk assessment has not changed and we will continue to operate in the same way in summer term 2.

There have been some positives to take from the whole experience of having to adapt the school day and to how we operate logistically, please read the Covid Keeps – September 2021 section for the reasoning behind some of the changes that will remain.

Most notably, the timings of the school day. From September, the timings of the school day will be as follows.

There are many reasons for continuing to stagger the school day (see Covid Keeps). We understand that this can be difficult if you have multiple children in school however, the day will not be as staggered as it is now and doors will be open at least 10 minutes before the school start time to help make sure you can get your children into school without having to wait around.

The timings of the school day ensure considerably more hours of leaning than the statutory guidance of 21 hours for EYFS and KS1 and 23.5 hours a week for KS2.

Covid Keeps – September 2021

Amongst all the uncertainty, worry and disruption to schools caused by Covid, there have been some positives along the way. We have had to adapt to a new way of operating and have been forced to change things logistically, many of which have worked well.

We will continue to do some of the things that have worked well and have even been advantageous.

We still do not know what restrictions will be in place for schools in September and we anticipate that school life may not return completely as it was before. This makes some things difficult to plan.

However, when we return in September, the following things will remain in place:

- The school day will continue to be staggered (but not as much as before).
 Positive: This has helped to alleviate traffic and parking problems around school, making the roads safer for the children.
- School will start and finish earlier, with a 50-minute lunch break.
 Positive: Children learn best in the morning and are tired in the afternoon.
 Longer mornings have been more productive. Shorter lunchtimes have meant less behaviour issues.
- Play times will be staggered.
 Positive: More space and less first aid issues.
- Children will continue to wear PE kit all day on their PE days.
 Positive: Less time wasted changing, longer PE lessons, less lost property.
- Allocated entry points for year groups will remain in place.

Positive: This has helped with traffic, parking and congestion of traffic and people around the school gates.
