




Nursery Timings

We will be in the Preschool Little Owls building from September.


Come through any entrance for 8.30 start and end of the day as all gates are open.






Early Years Rules

- Please label everything!







You must inform us if your child is not going to be in school. Please ring the school office and leave a message.


- If your child is ill or has a medical appointment

- A leave of absence form must be completed if they are off for any other reason




Funding


