This week we have looked at 'stories of three'



Literacy

We have learned two vowel digraphs, 'ee' and 'oa' this week.

We have also learned to read the tricky word, 'was', and writing the words 'no' and 'go'.

The children have talked about the main elements of fairy tales (settings, characters, problems, solutions and magic) and recorded them on a 'fairy tale formula' for the story "The Three Wishes".

We have also mapped out "The Three Billy Goats Gruff" using pictures to retell the story.



Mathematics

Maths Mastery this week has introduced the concept and vocabulary of 'whole and part'.

We have looked at different things that have parts that can be taken off and put back on, or deconstructed and constructed. We have also thought about things that have parts but cannot be deconstructed, like ourselves!

We have then seen how this can happen with numbers, that 2 is a part of 3 and 1 is a part of 3, and the whole is 3.
