This week we have been thinking about how friends to play together.



Our sounds this week are g, o, c, and k.

We have practised letter formation, thought of words with these sounds, and played several games to develop our blending and segmenting skills. We have also started working in our guided groups, each group reading an Oxford Reading Tree book, and practising writing c/o/a.



This week's learning has focused on numeral recognition and putting numbers in order. We have counted forwards and backwards and have talked about what number comes before or after a given number.



Other Areas of Learning

It was tremendous fun helping jelly baby friends play together.

The children chose a game or activity for the jelly babies to do and then we photographed them. We talked about what they were doing and how they were playing together nicely!
