- Consolidating counting in 2s, 5s and 10s
- Developing a mathematical vocabulary to talk about and compare different measures, including distance, weight and capacity

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Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Learning to describe themselves and others in positive terms, particularly seeing the positive aspects of other cultures
- Develop an understanding of people's feelings and how our actions can affect others
