Dear parents and carers,

As Covid related school absence hit a new high last week, we had to close the 2C bubble on Monday due to a positive case. As you can imagine, this is frustrating after getting this far with no closures.

The close contact rules are still in place so please be cautious and do not send your children to school if anyone in your household has symptoms to help avoid further closures for the last few days.

I am sure you will have seen the government announcement in the news that Covid rules are being changed in school from September and there will no longer be 'bubbles'. We are currently waiting for this to be confirmed on a local council level and we will keep you informed if anything changes.

Despite the government announcement, for reasons outlined in the previous newsletter, we are going to continue to stagger the school day but not to the same extent as before. I can confirm that the timings of the school day will be as follows:
