Dear parents and carers,

As we approach the end of the year, the restrictions and council guidance remain in place at school.

Unfortunately, assemblies, discos, sports days and other such end of term events cannot take place.

There will **be no end of year reports** this year for children in Y1 – Y6 as mid-year reports were sent to parents three weeks before the school closures. Nursery and Reception did not have mid-year reports so will have end of year reports that will be either posted out before the end of term or given to parents if your child(ren) have returned to school.

I very much appreciate your help and ongoing support with home learning, we recognise that this is a challenging situation for all families. I think it is important that we all recognise children do not work for the whole day at school and set tasks usually take between **20 minutes and 45 minutes** depending on the children's age. At school, children would do one English and one Maths task per day. Children would usually read for between 20 minutes and 30 minutes each day and in the afternoon would do practical Science and foundations subject topic-based work including Art, DT, PE, Music, French, Geography, History Computing and Skills Academy on a Friday. We recognise that it is difficult to re-create the afternoons in school so hope you can focus on short bursts of Maths, English and reading.

I must remind everyone that all teachers are now back in the classroom and teaching/supervising children of critical workers and children in Nursery, Reception, Y1 and Y6. We now have between **140 and 160** children attending school each day, which is considerably higher than many other local schools, so teachers may not always be available on Google Classroom.

We will keep you updated when we know more from the government and the council about how school will re-open fully.

Summer Holidays

Unfortunately, we are unable to run a holiday club this summer or provide emergency childcare during the summer holidays.

The school has been open continuously since we returned after February half term, including all school holidays, which has meant we have had no choice but to push essential repairs and maintenance work back to the summer. For the essential maintenance to take place there will be multiple contractors and machinery on site making school unsafe, the electricity and water will be switched off, therefore we have no choice but for school to be closed in preparation for re-opening safely in September.

If you require emergency childcare, please note community hubs will be open and you will need to contact the council to book a place.

Year 6 - 7 Transition

Most secondary schools have created a Year 6/7 transition section on their websites containing relevant information, FAQ's and most have a virtual tour video as well.

If your child's secondary has not yet done this – it should be ready soon.

Owls before and after school club

We plan to re-open our Owls before and after school club during the second week of September. We are unsure at this stage what restrictions will be in place, but we must plan ahead.

In preparation for re-opening we must consider limiting numbers and will no longer be able to offer a 'pay as you go' system. In line with most other childcare providers, you will now be expected to book the before and after school places in advance. Further information will follow.
