These are the arrangements for children returning to Nursery on **Monday 15<sup>th</sup> June.**

- All Nursery children are offered three sessions per week, on **Monday, Tuesday and Thursday**. Nursery is closed to all children on **Wednesdays and Fridays** so that the classroom can be cleaned.
- Morning sessions are **8.30 – 11.00 am** with Mrs Lindsay and Leah Sealey. Afternoon sessions are **1.00 – 3.30 pm** with Raman Johal and Carol Breslin. Children **must be collected promptly** at the end of their Nursery session.
- Parents are requested to use the Guilsborough Gate to access the school site, as this is closest to the Nursery classroom.
- Children do **not** have to wear uniform. They should wear a fresh set of clothes every day they attend. They should wear clothes that are comfortable, suitable for the weather of that day, and that they can manage **independently**. **Absolutely no shoe laces**. Children will also need a coat for going outdoors. Long hair must be tied back.
- Please ensure your child arrives in school with sun cream applied, a hat and a water bottle.
- Your child will need to bring with them a box of tissues. This means they will not have to get tissues from a box that other children are using. They will be encouraged to 'Catch it, bin it, kill it' and the wash their hands. You can also practise this at home.
- Children may bring a snack from home to have during the session. This should be a cereal bar or piece of fruit.
- If your child requires an inhaler then we will only assist them if absolutely necessary. Please teach your child to use their inhaler and spacer so they can do this as independently as possible. If your child requires any other medication, then it may be safer to keep them at home until they are better and no longer require medication.
- If your child is distressed upon arrival at the classroom, while every effort will be made to support them emotionally, it may be necessary to take them back home. You will be unable to come into the classroom with them and staff will be unable to support them with any physical help in order to come in.
- PLEASE BE AWARE OF SOCIAL DISTANCING ON SCHOOL SITE AT ALL TIMES. YOUR CHILD MUST REMAIN WITH YOU, THEY MAY NOT PLAY AND MUST NOT GO TO ANY OTHER CHILD.
