Mathematics

- Counting to 20 and beyond, also counting in 10s
- Recognising and ordering numerals to 20
- Working out one more or one less
- Simple addition, combining two groups and finding a total
- Developing a vocabulary for positional language
- Developing a vocabulary to talk about time, eg day, month, season etc

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Understanding the World

- Looking at events in our own lives and the lives of people we know, eg birthdays, Halloween etc.
- Understanding what and how people celebrate in different cultures
- Interactive white board games

Physical Development

- P.E. with Callum Burgess
- Developing gymnastic skills
- Developing strength and balance
- Continue to be independent when changing for P.E.
- Handling a variety of tools safely and with control

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Continuing to follow the rules and school values of Respect, Responsibility, and Resilience
