Owls before and after school club

PE Kit and Uniform

We have reviewed our uniform policy and made one minor change regarding PE kit.

We now ask that children wear their PE kits all day on the days that they have PE or if they have chosen a sporting Skills Academy Club.

Following a letter sent out last week, notifying parents of a new school kit supplier, I would like to stress PE kit **does not** have to have the school logo.

We would prefer PE kit to be black and white only. We recognise that you may have already bought kit for this year, so we are not expecting anyone to replace existing kit.

Black and white PE kit will be compulsory for all year groups from September 2021. Uniform and PE kit with school logos will not be compulsory.

Changes to Risk Assessment and Logistics

I would like to remind everyone that the school start times outlined on the re-opening letter are the times that the children should be in the classroom and settled for registration.

Classroom doors will be open 10 minutes before the actual start time for each year group. This should help with limiting the numbers on site at any one time. As soon as you have dropped your child off or collected your child, we ask that you leave the school site as soon after as possible to ensure social distancing is possible.

Important notice for parents of children in 1S

The area outside the classroom is small and the paths are narrow near the Y1 doors. When you drop off and collect your children, could you please use the KS1 playground. There is no need to wait on the path or outside the door. This will help with social distancing and avoid crowding.

Google Classroom

Now that all the children have google classroom accounts, we have decided to continue to use google classroom whenever possible for setting and receiving homework.

Children from Y1 to Y6 will receive weekly homework tasks for English and maths and will be given topic-based homework projects at various points in the year.

This will help with limiting the number of books and worksheets used that could cause cross-contamination of Covid-19.

There may be times when google classroom is not appropriate, depending on the nature of the homework task/activity.
