Dear parents and carers,

I am pleased to say that our first two weeks back in school have run smoothly. The children are back where they belong and have adjusted well to the changes as restrictions continue to ease and school life gradually begins to return to normal.

This term, children will continue to have limited contact with others outside of their year group and parts of the school day will continue to be staggered. However, year groups/bubbles no longer need to close should children or staff be in close contact with someone who has tested positive.

However, should we have multiple cases of Covid within school, we would have to implement an outbreak management plan which would result in additional restrictions such as returning to bubbles.

As you are aware we have already had several positive cases within school amongst children and staff. We continue to urge you to be cautious and test children if they have been in close contact with someone who has tested positive for Covid.

We also ask that you are cautious and do not send your child(ren) to school if they have symptoms of Covid or/and are awaiting a Covid test result.

#### Owls before and after school club

**Our school office and admin team** are here to take phone calls and messages and they work hard to ensure communication between parents and teaching staff is effective. They are not here to be spoken to aggressively or abusively about school related issues.

These continue to be challenging times for schools and despite the media suggesting that schools can return to normal, the local position states that some restrictions and mitigations remain in place.

We are always open to constructive feedback and here to listen to concerns however, unconstructive and continuous complaining is not welcome or helpful to anyone. Abusive or threatening behaviour will certainly not be tolerated.

#### Please download the School Gateway App to receive messages, letters and alerts



It is essential that you download the School Gateway App to make sure you receive school messages, updates and letters direct to your mobile phone. Download the App from the App store. Input your email address that is on your contact form. To request a PIN click forgotten PIN. Then enter your mobile number. If this does not work, you must contact the school office to check that your details match your details on our system.
