What is the Sports Premium?

The Government has provided funding until 2020 to provide new, substantial primary school sport funding. This funding is being jointly provided by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture, Media and Sport, and will see money going directly to primary school Head Teachers to spend on improving the quality of sport and PE for all their children.

The sport funding can only be spent on sport and PE provision in schools. OFSTED will play a significant role in ensuring that schools target this funding in areas which will lead to clear outcomes in raising standards and opportunities in PE and school sport for all children throughout the Primary Phase. In 2017 the Department for Education issued a statement explaining that schools will receive “double” the amount of funding following the introduction of the Sugar Tax.

Purpose of funding

Schools will have to spend the sport funding on improving their provision of PE and sport, but they will have the freedom to choose how they do this.

Possible uses for the funding include:

- hiring specialist PE teachers or qualified sports coaches to work alongside primary teachers when teaching PE
- new or additional sport clubs
- paying for professional development opportunities in PE/sport
- providing cover to release primary teachers for professional development in PE/sport
- running sport competitions, or increasing participation in the school games
- buying quality assured professional development modules or materials for PE/sport
- providing places for pupils on after school sport clubs and holiday clubs.

2017-2018 Review

During 2017-2018 the PE and School Sport Premium objective was to achieve self-sustaining improvement in the quality of PE and sport in primary schools against 5 key indicators:

1. The engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity
2. Improve the profile of PE and sport as a tool for whole school improvement
3. Increase confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff teaching PE
4. Provide broader experiences of a range of sports and activities to all pupils
5. Increase participation in competitive sport

A review of our PE and sports provision and the impact of the sports premium funding indicated that all five areas have been addressed and specifically the profile of PE across the school has raised significantly. It also highlighted further areas to work on in 2018-2019.

Our focus was to increase the participation of children involved in regular physical activity across the school. New equipment was purchased so children had access to a variety of equipment during break and lunch times. This inspired children of all abilities and encourage children who wouldn't have previously been involved to participate. During the Summer months, tennis was very popular and so we decided to take a group of children to Wimbledon which was successful in igniting their interest further. Children were signposted to a local club. New lunchtime clubs were also offered by our sports coach within school and our sports coach from an outside agency. By the end of the Summer term 22% of SEND children and 10% of pupil premium children were not involved in extra-curricular clubs and so these will be our target groups next year. The involvement of girls and boys is generally even across the year. Further equipment was purchased to enable teachers and sports coaches to deliver high quality PE lessons.

Sports leaders assisted in raising the profile of PE across the school. 10 children in Year 6 were nominated by their peers and assisted in various sporting events which the younger children took part in and on Sports Day. Our review indicated that next year a greater number of sports leaders would be beneficial to increase the profile further. Children were also provided with various opportunities to take part in sporting competitions across the city and reported their results and success in assemblies. Having two sports coaches who did extra practise with the children at break times ensured that children were fully prepared for each competition they took part in. To increase staff confidence, we now have two sports coaches whom teach alongside teachers. We also employ a dance and yoga teacher to support in this specialist area. Staff confidence in teaching PE is increasing but this is an area we will continue to work on next academic year.

The PE team were upskilled by attending various courses and this was put into practise during lessons. This also allowed us as a school to provide a wider range of sports such as Ultimate Frisbee and use the ethos of teamwork and respect during warmups to encourage ALL children to enjoy physical activity and recognise the long-term benefits.

SPORTING ACHEIEVEMENTS FROM 2017-2018

Last academic year, children at EGPS were given the opportunity to take part in numerous competitions within school and against other schools. Below, is a table of results which highlights our achievements. We aim to build on this success during the current academic year.
