

## Art Essential skills Year 3

Aspect	Skill
Sketch Book	Make/use a simple sewn sketch book, selecting a range of papers and fabrics for different purposes.
Developing Ideas	Identify interesting aspects of objects as a starting point for work.
Selection	Explain the purpose of a given task and identify the ideal materials and tools for the job.
Drawing	Use a range of drawing media to draw natural and man-made items, giving attention to pattern, shape and form.
Painting	Copy and create patterns and textures with a range of paints.
3-D	Use a range of modelling materials and tools, choosing the one most appropriate to a given task.
Printmaking	Make repeat pattern prints for decorative purposes using various natural materials.
Collage	Use a variety of materials to create a collage on a theme.
Photography	Take photographs and explain their creative vision.
Colour	Create and use a palate of natural colours to paint from outdoor observation.
Pattern	Imprint a range of patterns into modelling materials (e.g clay, dough and papier mâché).
Line and Tone	Use line to add surface detail to a drawing, print or painting.
Form	Create natural forms such as shells, leaves, flowers and animals showing an awareness of different viewpoints of the same object.
Evaluating	Make suggestions for ways to adapt/ improve own artwork.
Appreciating	Use a range of artistic vocabulary to compare artworks of a particular genre or movement.
